Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament Entry is open to all senior members within the area sanctioned by the Southern Nevada USBC Association. (SNUSBCA). Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this association who are not members of another association may enter by paying an unattached membership fee consisting of the current dues for USBC, State and local associations. Those belonging to another association must pay \$13.00 (in-state association fee = \$11.00). Bowler must have turned 50 years of age prior to bowling the tournament.
- 2. **Entry Fee** is \$35.00 per person. Entry fee must accompany the completed entry form and bowling will not be permitted unless all fees have been paid. No refunds of the entry fee will be made after the entry has been accepted and scheduled.
- 3. **Tournament Format** will consist of four (4) games.
- 4. **Multiple Participation:** Bowlers may bowl more than once, but the bowlers may not cash in consecutive positions.
- 5. Lanes will be conditioned prior to each squad. This tournament will be bowled on the USBC White #2 pattern.
- 6. All entries will close 1/2 hour prior to each squad. There will be no exceptions to this rule.
- 7. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between each bowler's entering average and 230.
- 8. Prize Ratio and Awards each division will pay a ratio of 1 in 5 and all prizes will be returned 100%.
- Averages: In accordance with USBC Rule 319a, all bowlers are required to submit the highest average of a single USBC league based on the following hierarchy:
 - a. Highest 2016-2017 Winter book average with at least 21 games.
 - b. Highest 2017 Summer average with at least 21 games.
 - c. Highest 2015-2016 Winter book average with at least 21 games.
 - d. Highest 2016 Summer average with at least 21 games.
 - e. Highest current average with at least 21 games bowled prior to bowling in tournament. A copy of the league standings will be required.
 - f. All others must use 230 (Scratch).
 - g. No Sport or Tough Shot averages will be used.
 - h. When an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins or more than the prior season's average, the current average must be used. A current standing sheet **must** be provided prior to bowling in this event. Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her own average. All bowlers with an average in another Association for the previous season shall furnish verification from their previous Association Manager in writing before closing date of this tournament. Failure to follow this rule may result in disqualification from the tournament.
 - i. In accordance with Rule 319c, the average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded.
 - j. Rule 319d: Reporting (in writing) of previous prize winnings of \$300 in an event, combined prize money exceeding \$500 in a tournament and \$1,000 or more in tournaments completed in within the past 12 months.
 - k. Rule 319e: A bowler shall adjust his/her entering average if, during the 12-month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all (but not less than 21) tournament games, exceed the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes.
- 10. Divisions (based on averages):

Division A: 1-160 Division B: 161-180 Division C: 181-200 Division D: 201 and Up

- 11. Replacements must be made at least ½ hour before scheduled squad time, unless deemed as an emergency.
- 12. **Dress Code** participants must wear a shirt, and trousers, jeans, skirts or dress shorts. Skirts or dress shorts must be at fingertip length. Traditional collared shirts, mock collared shirts and collarless bowling jerseys are all permitted. For our women bowlers, shorts must be of fingertip length at a minimum. During participation, bowlers are NOT PERMITTED to wear, sweats, zubas (pants with elastic cuffs), halter tops, tank tops, spaghetti strap shirts or any athletic style shorts. All clothing must be neat, clean, and free of offensive images or wording and in good condition. Dress code will be enforced by the tournament staff and they will make any judgment calls related to attire based on any special circumstances or medical exemptions.
- 13. Decisions and Appeals The tournament director shall have the authority to make any changes in the schedule, both to lanes and times. Copies of scores will be available for all contestants. No corrections in scores will be allowed 24 hours after the score is bowled, except for obvious errors. All changes must be made by a tournament official. The tournament committee shall decide any questions not covered by these or USBC Sanctioned Tournament Rules. The decision of the committee shall be final unless an appeal is made to USBC Headquarters within 10 days of notification of the tournament director's decision. See USBC Rule 329 for Appeal Procedure.
