Rules for the 2025 Southern Nevada USBC Association Youth Championship

1. Marketing Statement: By participating in this event, your legal guardian grants permission to Southern Nevada USBC Association to use your name(s), likeness, image, voice and/or appearance in any photographs, video recordings, digital images, and other media representations, taken or made for SNUUSBCA marketing and publicity activities including, but not limited to, social media channels, website publication, magazine publications, advertisements, and any promotional or educational materials offered both online or in digital or print format.

2. The 2025 Southern Nevada USBC Association Youth Championship is certified by the USBC and is open to all 2024-2025 Southern Nevada USBC Association Youth U18 members who compete in local youth bowling leagues. Please register early. **Registration closes 1 hour prior to each squad time.** There will be no exceptions.

Note: You must display your current USBC Youth Certification (electronic device or card) at check in. If you do not have a current membership, you must purchase one prior to your squad time. Certification cards may be re-printed/displayed at bowl.com in the 'Find a Member' section. Any tournament official can assist you with finding your USBC info, but please do so before registration.

The tournament shall consist of 4-person Teams, Doubles and/or Singles. The Singles and All-Events rankings shall be divided into Boys and Girls Divisions. Handicapped competitions will be segmented into Divisions based on current average, listed on Page 2 of this entry form. If any Division has less than 8 (eight) entries, the average ranges will be adjusted, and Divisions may be combined/eliminated at the Directors' discretion.

3. Bowlers will bowl 3 games in each entered event. Bowlers may re-enter any event as often as space is available, however, each new Team or Doubles must have a 50% change from the previous line-up. Only the FIRST score in each Single/Doubles/Team event will count towards All-Events. Only the HIGHEST score in the Singles event will be eligible for Scholarship Awards.

Scratch Division is optional and is open to all Bowlers, however the All-Events must be composed of only scratch events. Competition is ranked by total pinfall with zero handicap. Those entering this division are not eligible for Handicap All-Events, however they may enter Handicap events on a separate entry.

4. Bowlers should bring applicable standing sheets for average verification to each squad they bowl. Averages are subject to change after verification by a tournament official. Entering averages shall be determined in the order as follows:

5. a) Highest current USBC-sanctioned league average of 21 games or more as of Friday, January 17, 2025. Submit your most current at the time of registration, and bring the up-to-date verification at check-in. Your league coordinator may supply by proxy.
- b) Highest USBC book average from prior 3 seasons (Winter 2021 - Summer 2024).
- c) Averages from CCSD, JBT Mojave, LVB, and Jr. Gold Nationals (21-game minimum through Summer 2024) may be submitted with verification. See your league director accordingly for a verification letter and game record.
- d) Bowlers without either above average will have until their scheduled squad time to establish their 21-game average from their current league (e.g. as makeup/pre-bowl), which must be verified in writing from their league director.
- e) All others will be assigned an average of 200, with 0 handicap.

Note: Challenge and Sport averages will be re-rated to Standard (USBC Rule # 319a-c). Bowlers are responsible for reporting and using their highest current average (if more than one league). Failure to do so may result in disqualification from the Tournament. Please note the type of average on the entry form, e.g. Sport, Challenge, Standard.

6. Handicaps will be computed as follows:

Singles	-	90% of 200
Doubles	-	90% of 400
Team	-	90% of 800

7. Entry fees per person, per event are broken down as follows:

a) Lineage	\$9.00
b) Expenses	\$1.00
c) Scholarship Fund	\$20.00
Total	\$30.00



Note: Each bowler who enters the optional All-Events will pay an additional \$5.00. All-Events fees will be added, in their entirety, to the Scholarship fund.

No checks will be accepted the day of the event, only cash and credit cards. Returned Check Policy: Any and all fees and related bank charges must be paid immediately.

8. Registration is not confirmed until entry fees are received. Please submit completed entry form to a Tournament Director or Secretary by January 11, 2025 for timely processing. For convenience, online registration and payment is greatly encouraged, at www.sonvbowl.com. No refunds will be issued once [squad registration](#) has closed.

Scholarships will be awarded to first place in each Division. Additional Scholarships may be awarded based on the number of
9. entries in each Division (1-in-6 to 1-in-8 typically) except All-Events. Tournament Officials reserve the right to combine Divisions if there are insufficient entries. All awards will be returned 100% to the bowlers as scholarships, which will be held in trust by the USBC SMART Program, Arlington Texas, account # 9815. Please allow up to 90 days for allocation to individual bowlers' SMART accounts. Notify Tournament Director or the Southern Nevada USBC Association for any discrepancies.
10. Bowlers will bowl in the order listed on the entry form. Substitutes will be permitted in the Team and Doubles events in the specific line-up position. Should the average of the substitute change the Division of the entry, it will be reclassified. Once a substitute has scored their first ball, the substitute shall complete the event in progress. Scores earned as a substitute are only eligible for All-Events if all three qualifying events are bowled by the one substitute bowler.
11. Late starting bowlers will receive ZERO (0) score for frames missed. Bowlers not ready to bowl when it is their turn will receive zero (0) score for every frame missed, unless a Tournament Official has authorized delay.
12. Suitable Tournament attire must be worn, and bowlers must be so dressed at check-in. Crew/sash style bowling jerseys are acceptable, but otherwise a plain collared shirt or jersey is expected. Long or short slacks and skirts are expected. Skirts/Shorts must be absolutely no shorter than mid-thigh. No tank tops, spandex, fleece, or sagging pants, will be permitted, nor any clothing depicting obscene language, gestures, alcohol, or tobacco products. No head gear of any kind will be allowed. Final determination of proper attire will be at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
13. Bowlers (and parents in the bowling area) are not permitted the use of tobacco or alcoholic products during Tournament play. Beverages and food are permitted but must be kept in the area behind the bowlers' settee area. Offensive language, hand gestures and kicking or hitting of the equipment will not be tolerated and offenders may be removed immediately from the event in progress. This will be STRICTLY enforced. The use of electronic devices, including headsets, cell phones, tablets, PSP's, etc. will NOT be allowed by Tournament bowlers during their competition.
14. Only Tournament Bowlers, Officials, and Bowling Center Staff will be permitted in the settee area. Only Tournament Officials and Bowling Center Staff may make score corrections or reset pins.
15. All USBC Youth Tournament Rules and Regulations shall apply, except where otherwise specified in these Tournament Rules. The Tournament Director shall have the power to hear and act on all protests arising from this Tournament and shall decide any and all questions not covered by the rules. Any Protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 30 minutes of completion of the Squad in protest.
16. Posted Tournament standings are considered preliminary until an audit has been completed and official results released. Final awards lists and standings will be posted within 30 days of the last squad of the Tournament on the SNUSBCA website www.sonvbowl.com.
17. Bowlers agree to follow all directives issued by federal, state, and local authorities designed to ensure public safety regarding gatherings/events.
