Tournament Rules

- 1. Tournament Entry is open to all members within the area sanctioned by the Southern Nevada USBC Association. (SNUSBCA). Non- members living within the jurisdiction of this association who are not members of another association may enter by paying an unattached membership fee consisting of the current dues for USBC, State and local associations (\$32.00) Those belonging to another association must pay the current state and local association fees as applicable. (In-state association fees = \$2.00 for state and \$15.00 for local).
- 2. Entry Fee: \$30.00 per person, per event. Entry fee must accompany all entries. Bowlers wishing to participate in optional Handicap and/or Scratch All-Events must mark an (x) in the space provided on the entry form. The fee for the Handicap All-Events is \$15 per person and the fee for the Scratch All-Events is \$20 per person. If you elect to bowl the Optional Virtual Scratch Event(s), you must mark an (x) in the space provided on the entry form and add \$20 for each event bowled to your entry fee. No refunds of entry fee will be made after the entry has been accepted and scheduled. Exceptions require approval of Association Manager.
- Tournament Format will consist of three (3) games for Team and six (6) games for Doubles and Singles (Doubles and Singles are bowled together and Doubles is bowled first).
 - Multiple Participation: USBC Rule 315 will apply in this tournament.
 - a. Participation in the Team event is unlimited but must change at least two members to cash more than once.
 - b. Participation in the Doubles event is unlimited, but may only cash once with the same partner. All doubles entrants must bowl singles for each entry
 - c. Participation in the Singles event must equal the number of the double's entries. Multiple singles may cash more than once but may not cash in consecutive position
 - d. For All-Events, a contestant participating in more than one team, doubles and singles event must use their first scores for each event.
 - e. Rules 4a, 4b and 4c also apply to the optional Virtual Scratch event(s). The Doubles partners for this event must be the same as used in the initial entry.
 - f. To qualify for All-Events, fees must be paid prior to bowler's first event in the tournament.
- 5. Averages: USBC Rule 319a will apply: The bowler is required to submit the previous season's highest average of a single USBC league average based on a minimum of 21 games. If a 21 game average in any one league does not exist, the bowler must use a composite average of 21 games if available. When an entrant has a current average for 21 or more games that is 10 pins or higher than the prior season's average, the current average must be used. A current standing sheet must be provided prior to bowling in this event. Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. All bowlers with an average in another association for the previous season will furnish verification from their previous Association Manager in writing before closing of this tournament. Failure to follow this rule may result in disqualification from the tournament. This rule applies to any average obtained prior to the date that the bowler first bowls in the tournament. The following hierarchy will be used.
 - a. Highest 2023-2024-winter/summer-book average with at least 21games.
 - **b.** Highest 2022-2023 winter/summer-book average with at least 21 games.
 - c. Highest current average with at least 21 games bowled prior to bowling in tournament. This same average will be used throughout the tournament. A copy of the league standings will be required.
 - d. All others must use 220 (Scratch).
 - e. Bowlers with documented averages for each hand must use the highest average for the chosen hand. This must be done prior to the start of the bowler's competition in the tournament and may not be changed during the tournament.
 - f. No Sport or Challenge shot averages will be used. With the following exception. If a bowler has an adjusted sport or challenge shot average that is 15 or more pins higher than their book average, the adjusted sport or challenge shot average must be used. The USBC Average Conversion Chart will be used to determine entering average for tournament.
- 6. Handicap: Handicap will be based on 100% of 220. Team and Doubles handicaps are computed using individual handicaps. The maximum score for any game regardless of handicap is 300.
- **Divisions:**
 - a. Open Division 1 Team 797 and above, Doubles of 399 and above and Singles/AE 200 and above
 b. Open Division 2 Team 697 796, Doubles 349 398 and Singles/AE 175 199

 - Open Division 3 Team 696 or lower, Doubles 348 or lower and Singles/AE 174 or lower
 - d. Team entries may contain only two (2) current PBA bowlers and Doubles pairings may only have one (1) bowler defined as a professional bowler.
 - e. For the purpose of participation in the SONV Open Championships (AKA City Tournament), Professional Bowlers are defined as: Any bowler, regardless of age, having applied for membership or held membership in ANY professional bowling organization during the calendar year (Jan. 1 - Dec. 31, 2024) preceding the event, and or up through their dates of their competition in 2025.
- USBC Rule 14 will apply: No member of USBC shall participate or be involved in the operation of a scheme or arrangement requiring a supplemental fee of any type or character for the purpose of having any part or all a player's score in USBC league or tournament play qualify for a prize where competing entrants bowl in different bowling centers. Please see bowl.com for more information on exceptions.
- USBC Rule 319d will apply: (Reporting Prior Prize Winnings).
 - a. Within the last 12-month period, anyone who has qualified for a cash and/or merchandise prize in the position standings prize list in a tournament, including all-events, special features, special prizes, and donated prizes, must give tournament management the following information prior to participation for possible average adjustment:
 - 1) The name of each tournament in which they have been paid the following prizes, or if not yet paid, in which they have qualified for the prize: 1) \$300 or more in any event; 2) Total combined prize winnings of \$500 or more in any one tournament; 3) Total combined prize winnings of \$1000 or more in all tournaments within the last 12-months.
 - 2) The amount of the prize.
 - 3) The actual score bowled to qualify for the prize.
 - 4) The prize position.
 - b. Failure to comply with these provisions is cause for a forfeiture of entry fees and prize winnings.
- 10. USBC Rules 319c and 319e will apply to all USBC members (Average adjustment/re-ratings appeal). In Accordance with Rule 319c, the average of a bowler may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the bowler does not accept the assigned average, entry fee(s) shall be refunded. Rule 319e, a bowler shall adjust his/her entering average if, during a 12-month period immediately preceding the time and date of bowling, the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins. In that case, the accumulated average must be used for handicapping or classification purposes. All certified and non-certified scores from the game of American Tenpins must be used in the adjustment of this rule. This includes PBA sanctioned events and all other unsanctioned events.
- 11. Decisions and Appeals: USBC Sanctioned Tournament Rules will govern any rules not covered. Decisions of the Tournament Director will be final unless an appeal is made within 10 days of notification and in accordance with USBC Rule 329. The Tournament Director will have the authority to make any changes in the schedule, both to lanes and times. Copies of scores will be available for all contestants. No corrections in scores will be allowed 24 hours after the score is bowled, except for obvious errors. All Changes must be made by a tournament official. All entries will close 1 hour prior to the scheduled start time of each squad. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.
- 12. Replacements must be made at least ½ hour before scheduled squad time, unless deemed as an emergency.
- 13. Dress Code: Participants must wear shirt and trousers, jeans, or dress shorts. Traditional collared shirts, mock collared shirts, collarless bowling jerseys and non- offensive Tshirts are all permitted. All shirts must have sleeves. During participation, bowlers are NOT PERMITTED to wear sweats, zubaz pants or any athletic style shorts. Women – Skirts are allowed and must be of fingertip length at a minimum. All clothing must be neat, clean and in good condition. The tournament staff will enforce the Dress Code and they will make any judgment calls related to attire based on any special circumstances or medical exemptions. Bowlers will be required to change if attire if deemed inappropriate.
- 14. Entry Fee Breakdown: Each event will pay a minimum of 1 in 5 for handicap and 1 in 6 for scratch. The optional virtual scratch event(s) will also pay a minimum of 1 in 6. All prize fees will be returned 100%. Note: Total entry fee per person bowling in Team/Doubles/Singles is \$90 (\$30 per event x 3). Per team bowling all three events the entry fee is \$360 (\$90 x 4).
